

Troop 318 SNOW Camping Checklist

Clothing

- ___ Long Underwear (Thermals)
- ___ Wool Pants
- ___ Wool Shirt
- ___ Extra Wool Shirt/Sweater/Coat
- ___ Water/Wind Proof Coat
- ___ Water/Wind Proof Pants (Snow Pants)
- ___ Wool Hat (Stocking Type)
- ___ Extra Clothes (In water-proof bag or in nearby car)
- ___ Gloves (Waterproof)
- ___ Spare Gloves or Mittens (stored dry)
- ___ Gaiters (if without Snow Pants)
- ___ Socks (2-3 pair of Wool socks, 2 pair 'wicking socks')
- ___ Sun Glasses (Glare/Wind Protection)
- ___ Snow Boots (Waterproof)

Other Personal Gear

- ___ Sleeping bag with Wool/Fleece liner, or
- ___ TWO sleeping bags, one to be used inside the other
- ___ Sleeping pad, to keep you separated from/off the snow
- ___ Plastic ground cover to lay underneath sleep gear and to stop potential water uptake
- ___ Mess Kit (Bowl, Cup, Spoon, Fork) for personal use
- ___ Ten Essential Plus, kit: Personal Snack Food (Hi-Energy, Sun Screen, Lip Balm, Personal Water Container (drink plenty of water all the time), Space Blanket, Ace Bandage, Pain Reliever (Aspirin), Anti-Bacterial Ointment, Bandages (Personal First Aid Kit), Pocket Knife, Matches (Fire Starter), Rain Poncho
- ___ Waterproof container to hold all clothing material (Plastic bag / plastic chest
- ___ Rope to tie closed personal waterproof bags
- ___ Flashlight (One that is proven to work, with extra batteries)
- ___ Candles (If you build a snow cave this will be important, otherwise NOT)
- ___ Positive Mental Attitude (Have fun and be safe)
- ___ Toilet Paper
- ___ Toothbrush, toothpaste
- ___ Personal Hygiene (Purell Sanitizer), Soap, Towel, etc.
- ___ Money for meals on the trip
- ___ Spare foam pad for sitting, keeps fanny warm and dry (Bleacher seat)

General Gear for Use by ALL

- ___ Any snow devices used to Transport gear to and from camp, and for FUN
- ___ Snow shoes or other snow walking devices
- ___ Snow shovels or devices for carving and digging in snow
- ___ Tarps for under and over equipment as required
- ___ Rope for tying gear on sleds and to fasten tarps and secure poles, etc.
